

# Hughes Avenue Reconstruction

Hughes Avenue lacks pedestrian facilities, has failing pavement and the intersection of Hughes at Peace Portal Drive is skewed such that it hampers truck turning movements and creates a safety risk to motorists. Hughes Avenue is the southern route into the Blaine industrial area and experiences a significant volume of truck traffic. The project will remedy the intersection challenges, provide pedestrian facilities on the north side of the street, and will improve the pavement so that it holds up to truck traffic. Construction is anticipated to take 5 months, and is scheduled to begin on April 8, 2019.
